On 6/22/12 at approximately 0215 hrs. I (Ofc. Pheabus) was dispatched to Westminster MD. for a verbal domestic. Pfc. Ensor, Cpl. Long and I arrived and located a white male and a white female holding a baby. I explained that we were there to talk to them because we received a complaint of them arguing. I asked the male party if he had identification and he stated he did not. And then he refused to talk to me any more. Pfc. Ensor asked the female (later identified as Karen Crisafulli a Baltimore City Police Officer) to come over and speak to her and the female looked to the male party who advised her not to talk to us. He then looked at Pfc. Ensor and asked her if she worked for Baltimore City Police. He then said something to the female and they both walked away. I found this to be odd so we ran the vehicle license plates of the vehicles they were standing next to and through an MVA search we found a MVA picture of the male party involved. The male was identified as Brian Scott Rice. Pfc. Ensor advised me that she handled an accident that involved Brian Rice and she knew him to work for Baltimore City Police Department.

I responded back to Westminster City Police Department to enter a report and talked to Sgt. Pullen. When I updated Sgt. Pullen he advised me that he knew Brian Rice and that he was a Lieutenant with Baltimore City Police Department.

At this time Pfc. Ensor requested that Sgt. Pullen and I respond back to Laurier Drive and she briefed us with information that she had received that Brian Rice was a police officer and At this time we stayed in the area to check the welfare of Brian Rice, Karen Crisafulli and the baby. At approximately 0330 the Karen Crisafulli entered her residence and Brian Rice made a phone call on his cell phone and walked up the street. Sgt. Pullen, Pfc. Ensor and I checked the neighborhood for Brian Rice and could not locate him. It was later determined that Brian Rice left his vehicle parked at and walked away from the scene on foot.

On 6/22/12 at approximately 0215 hrs. this officer responded to [REDACTED] to assist unit 331 (Off. Pheabus) with a verbal domestic. Upon arrival officers located a white male and a white female standing in between two vehicle directly in front of [REDACTED] the female was holding an infant (approx. mths old) . The male subject later identified as Brian Scott Rice advised that he did not see anyone outside arguing. when a further inquiry was made regarding an argument he refused to give his name and instructed the female party standing next to him not to say anything. Mr. Rice stated to this officer " didn't you use to work in Baltimore City". This officer knew of Mr. Rice as this officer handled an accident several months prior in which Mr. Rice was involved in. Mr. Rice inquired as to who generated the call for service stating " was it her ex boyfriend".

This officer asked the female later identified as Karen Crisafulli what her name was, Ms. Crisafulli refused to speak to this officer. This officer observed that every time I would attempt to speak with her she would look directly at Mr. Rice. Both Mr. Rice and Ms. Crisafulli refused to provide any information and walked off and around the corner from officers.

This officer made contact with the complainant, Andrew Mcaleer in reference to the above listed call for service. Upon speaking to Mr. Mcaleer it was learned that he is currently dating Ms. Crisafulli and that both of them along with several children including the infant had just returned from vacation. Mr. Mcaleer stated when he pulled his vehicle into the parking lot in front of his house Mr. Rice was sitting inside a parked vehicle. Mr. Mcaleer took the children inside the home except fo the infant who was being held by Ms. Crisafulli. At that point Mr. Mcaleer heard both Mr. Rice and Ms. Crisafulli involved in a verbal argument out front. At some point he (Mcaleer) over heard Mr. Rice closing his vehicle trunk which concerned him. It was learned from Mr. Mcaleer that both Rice and Crisafulli are active members of the Baltimore City Police Department. Mr. Rice is currently a Lieutenant at the Western District while Ms. Crisafulli is a patrol officer in the Southeast District.

Mr. Mcaleer stated that Mr. Rice [REDACTED]

After speaking to Mr. Mcaleer this officer attempted to locate both parties to check the welfare of infant. Both Mr. Rice and Ms. Crisfulli were located up the street from [REDACTED] This officer made contact again with both parties who again refused to speak to this officer. Mr. Rice did state he did not wish to speak with me. This officer informed both that this agency was aware of their employment and would be contacting that jurisdiction/supervisors.

Both parties again not speaking with this officer began to walk down the street toward [REDACTED] This officer observed both stop in front of [REDACTED] and remain there together for several more minutes before Ms. Crisafulli entered the home with infant. Mr. Rice began to walk back up the street. Several area canvases were conducted in the neighborhood in an attempt to check the well being of Mr. Rice., officer's were unable to locate him. Officer's attempted to locate Mr. Rice for several hours as there was concern for his welfare.

This officer made contact with Baltimore city communications officer, Officer Bowie who contacted Sgt. La-Violai (IID) in reference to the above listed investigation. Mr. Rice's supervisor, Major Mcwhite was also notified.

After speaking with Major Mcwhite it was learned that Mr. Rice had called a friend and was transported home. Trooper Esposito (G96) responded out to [REDACTED] Rice residence. Once there he made numerous attempts to check the welfare of Mr. Rice, unfortunately Mr. Rice refused to answer the door.

This officer then received a phone call (departmental cell phone) from Mr. Rice. This officer advised Mr. Rice to step outside so that the Trooper can see that he was ok. Mr. Rice replied " You can tell them i'm fine". Mr. Rice originally refused to return to [REDACTED] to retrieve his vehicle but reluctantly agreed to let Sgt. Pullen pick him up and transport him to his vehicle.

Mr. Rice picked up the vehicle and left the area without further incident.

After completion of investigation Major Mcwhite and Sgt. La-Violai were advised of conclusion.

On 21 Sept 13 at approximately 2115 hours he was entering the Classico restuarant when he observed Brian Rice at the other end of the shopping center as he was pulling up near a garbage can by Safeway. He stated he observed Rice throw something into the trash can. He stated he thought this was unusual.							
Mcaleer stated after obtaing his food he walked down to the garbage can and looked inside at which time he reportedly found several pieces of his and his wife's mail.							
Mcaleer stated he contacted his wife Karen Mcaleer who advised she has not checked the mail the last couple of days.							
Andrew Mcaleer advised Rice is known to him as he is Karen Mcaleer's ex-husband and they have had problems in the past.							
This writer observed that one of the letters had a post mark of 9-18-13							
This writer spoke with Mike McGee store manager of Safeway and he advised there were no cameras in the area of the trash can near Dr. Johnson's former office.							
This writer spoke with Karen Mcaleer who advised she has not spoke with Andrew Mcaleer for approximately 2 weeks as they are having marital issues.
