On 12 April 2015 at approximately 0911 hours Mr. Grey was arrested in the 1700 block of Presbury and transported via wagon to the Western District. Upon arrival to the district, Mr. Grey was found unresponsive. Mr. Grey was laying on the wagon, on his left-side, with his head facing the wagon door. Medic 43 responded to district and transported Mr. Grey to Shock Trauma. Proper notifications were made. Force Investigation Team and Crime Lab 5821 responded to scene for photos and processing.

Minutes later, Lt. Rice request for back-up units to assist in the arrest of Donta Allen (M/1-NH/DOB: 7-9-1992) on the 1600 block of W. North Avenue. A wagon was requested, at which time Ofc. Goodson re-routed to pick up Mr. Allen. Due to Mr. Grey's continued combative disposition, Mr. Allen was placed in the left side of the wagon. After loading the second prisoner, Ofc. Goodson transported Mr. Allen back to the Western District holding cell for debriefing. I was then contacted by Ofc. Nero who requested that I respond back to the district to stand-by Mr. Allen, while he and Ofc. Miller and Lt. Rice continued bike patrol operations along the North Avenue corridor.

Upon reaching the district, I assisted Ofc. Goodson in unloading Mr. Allen. After placing Mr. Allen in the district's holding cell, I returned to the wagon. Upon opening the right side of the wagon holding Mr. Grey, I observed Mr. Grey on the floor to the wagon, laying on his left-side, with his head facing the wagon doors. I then proceeded to turn Mr. Grey, who appeared unconscious at the time. I began a sternum-rub in order to help Mr. Grey regain consciousness. When Mr. Grey did not respond to the sternum-rub, I sat Mr. Grey into the seated recovery position and requested a medic to respond to the district. When Mr. Grey was unable to keep his chin from resting on his chest, I supported his head in order to keep his airway open. Ofc. Porter and Sgt. White were present on scene while we awaited arrival of the medic.

Medic 43 responded to scene, at which time they stated that Mr. Grey was not breathing and assumed care of Mr. Grey. Medic 43 transported Mr. Grey to Univ. Maryland Shock Trauma. Crime Lab Tech Anderson (unit 5821) responded and processed the various scenes involved and Mr. Grey.

Further investigation revealed upon speaking with Lt. Rice and Officers Miller and Nero that the foot pursuit with Mr. Grey was initiated when Lt. Rice made eye-contact with Mr. Grey as they approached Mr. Grey at W. North Ave and N. Mount Street. According to Lt. Rice, Mr. Grey began to flee on foot southbound on N. Mount Street toward the Gilmor Home projects. Officer Miller advised that upon chasing Mr. Grey and upholstering his issued taser and yelling, "taser, taser taser!" - Mr. Grey surrendered. After Mr. Grey surrendered, Ofc. Miller advised he observed a knife-clip on Mr. Grey's front right pocket. Ofc. Miller stated he and Ofc. Nero then put Mr. Grey into custody upon discovery of the knife concealed in Mr. Grey's front right pocket. According to both Ofc. Nero and Miller, Mr. Grey was placed under arrest without any use of force. In addition, Ofc. Miller advised that at no point did he deploy his taser. Ofc. Miller also advised that when bystanders began to appear in the area, Mr. Grey began to yell and cause a commotion, at which point he requested the additional units to extract Mr. Grey safely.

Continued investigation revealed that Ofc. Miller had Ofc. Goodson stop the wagon at N. Mount and Baker so he could switch Mr. Grey to flex cuffs, apply leg restraints, and complete an arrest info receipt. According to Ofc. Miller, Mr. Grey continued to yell in a combative manner when temporarily removed from the wagon, and did not voluntarily re-enter the wagon when asked to do so. Due to his non-compliance, Lt. Rice advised he had to physically pick Mr. Grey up and place him into the wagon. Investigation of the incident was then assumed by the FIT. All proper notification were made.

On 12 April 2015 at approximately 0911 hours I responded to area of Presbury and N. Mount for a call for back-up from Lt. Rice, Ofc. Miller, and Ofc. Nero – who were attempting to apprehend a young black male, later identified as Mr. Freddie Grey (M/1-NH/DOB: 8-16-89) – who was fleeing on foot.

Responding to the scene, I observed Mr. Grey in the custody of Ofc. Nero and Miller. Ofc. Nero indicated that Mr. Grey was sufficiently under control, and directed me to assist Lt. Rice, who requested additional units to assist in canvassing for possible additional suspects believed to be in the rear of the 1700 block of N. Mount Street.

Myself and Ofc. Goodson responded to the rear of 1700 N. Mount and began our canvassing efforts. I heard loud yells coming from the vicinity of where Ofc. Nero and Ofc. Miller had Mr. Grey in custody. In addition, a crowd of bystanders from the Gilmor Homes, 1700 block of Presbury had begun to form and converge on the scene of arrest. Ofc. Miller then requested for the wagon to respond promptly to the scene in order to extract Mr. Grey from the area and avoid further confrontation.

At this point, I left the rear of 1700 N. Mount, heading on foot to Ofc. Nero and Ofc. Miller's location to assist in extracting Mr. Grey. Upon arrival, I observed Ofc. Nero and Ofc. Miller holding Mr. Grey who was lying face down in the prone arrest position, handcuffed in the rear. Mr. Grey continued to yell in an aggravated manner, as onlookers began to film the incident using cellphone video. Upon reaching Mr. Grey, I assisted Ofc. Nero with bringing Mr. Grey to his feet by hooking one arm under Mr. Grey's right armpit and lifting upward. Myself and Ofc. Nero then walked Mr. Grey to the wagon, during which time I heard Mr. Grey repeatedly state, "The cuffs are too tight." Myself and Ofc. Nero searched Mr. Grey at the step of the wagon, and then loaded Mr. Grey into the rear of the wagon, where he took a seated position. Once inside the wagon, Mr. Grey continued to yell and loud banging noises could be heard inside the wagon where Mr. Grey was presently seated. Ofc. Goodson then transported Mr. Grey from the 1700 block of Presbury. I then left the location in order to respond back to the Western District.

While enroute to the district, Ofc. Miller requested Ofc. Goodson to meet at Baker and N. Mount in order to complete arrest booking receipt for the arrest of Mr. Grey. Approximately 5 minutes later, additional units were requested to respond to Baker and N. Mount. I then left the district, and began responding to the location. Prior to my arrival, sufficient units were determined to be on scene. As I arrived on scene, I observed Ofc. Miller completing Mr. Grey's arrest booking receipt while other officers on scene acted as security from individuals who began to come onto the scene. Although I did not observe Mr. Grey at the time of my arrival, I continued to hear Mr. Grey yell and make banging noises from within the wagon.

Ofc. Goodson left the scene to transport Mr. Grey to CBIF for processing. Approximately 5 minutes later, Ofc. Goodson request an additional unit to respond to Druid Hill Ave and Dolphin Street to assist with Mr. Grey.
