Minutes later, Lt. Rice request for back-up units to assist in the arrest of Donta Allen (M/1-NH/DOB: 7-9-1992) on the 1600 block of W. North Avenue. A wagon was requested, at which time Ofc. Goodson re-routed to pick up Mr. Allen. Due to Mr. Grey's continued combative disposition, Mr. Allen was placed in the left side of the wagon. After loading the second prisoner, Ofc. Goodson transported Mr. Allen back to the Western District holding cell for debriefing. I was then contacted by Ofc. Nero who requested that I respond back to the district to stand-by Mr. Allen, while he and Ofc. Miller and Lt. Rice continued bike patrol operations along the North Avenue corridor. Upon reaching the district, I assisted Ofc. Goodson in unloading Mr. Allen. After placing Mr. Allen in the district's holding cell, I returned to the wagon. Upon opening the right side of the wagon holding Mr. Grey, I observed Mr. Grey on the floor to the wagon, laying on his left-side, with his head facing the wagon doors. I then proceeded to turn Mr. Grey, who appeared unconscious at the time. I began a sternum-rub in order to help Mr. Grey regain consciousness. When Mr. Grey did not respond to the sternum-rub, I sat Mr. Grey into the seated recovery position and requested a medic to respond to the district. When Mr. Grey was unable to keep his chin from resting on his chest, I supported his head in order to keep his airway open. Ofc. Porter and Sgt. White were present on scene while we awaited arrival of the medic. Medic 43 responded to scene, at which time they stated that Mr. Grey was not breathing and assumed care of Mr. Grey. Medic 43									
Further investigation revealed upon speaking with Lt. Rice and Officers Miller and Nero that the foot pursuit with Mr. Grey was initiated when Lt. Rice made eye-contact with Mr. Grey as they approached Mr. Grey at W. North Ave and N. Mount Street. According to Lt. Rice, Mr. Grey began to flee on foot southbound on N. Mount Street toward the Gilmor Home projects. Officer Miller advised that upon chasing Mr. Grey and upholstering his issued taser and yelling, "taser, taser taser!" – Mr. Grey surrendered. After Mr. Grey surrendered, Ofc. Miller advised he observed a knife-clip on Mr. Grey's front right pocket. Ofc. Miller stated he and Ofc. Nero then put Mr. Grey into custody upon discovery of the knife concealed in Mr. Grey's front right pocket. According to both Ofc. Nero and Miller, Mr. Grey was placed under arrest without any use of force. In addition, Ofc. Miller advised that at no point did he deploy his taser. Ofc. Miller also advised that when bystanders began to appear in the area, Mr. Grey began to yell and cause a commotion, at which point he requested the additional units to extract Mr. Grey safely. Continued investigation revealed that Ofc. Miller had Ofc. Goodson stop the wagon at N. Mount and Baker so he could switch Mr. Grey to flex cuffs, apply leg restraints, and complete an arrest info receipt. According to Ofc. Miller, Mr. Grey continued to yell in a combative manner when temporarily removed from the wagon, and did not voluntarily re-enter the wagon when asked to do so. Due to his non-compliance, Lt. Rice advised he had to physically pick Mr. Grey up and place him into the wagon. Investigation of the incident was then assumed by the FIT. All proper notification were made.
