I, the undersigned, apply for statement of charges and a summons or warrant which may lead to the arrest of the above named Defendant because on or about 22 March, 2016 at the Baltimore Central Booking and Intake Center (BCBIC), 300 E. Madison St., Baltimore, Maryland 21202, the above named Defendant

did conspire to commit, and did commit, assault on detainee [REDACTED]. Institutional surveillance video showed that the Defendant and detainee [REDACTED] both of whom were lawfully confined at the time, conferred for several minutes in the 4-South, A-dorm of BCBIC, before the victim, also lawfully confined, was approached and then directed to a corner of the dorm. As the victim turned his back, the Defendant struck him with a closed fist to the back/side of his head. The victim fell to the ground, striking it head/face first, and appeared to be unconscious (his body was stiff and he did not move). Detainee [REDACTED] then ran up to the prone, unconscious victim and using the heel of his right foot, stomped on the victim's head ten (10) times. Detainee [REDACTED] then dragged the victim into the middle of the area and punched him once in the head/neck

as he lay motionless on the floor.

The victim sustained a fractured skull and broken jaw as a result of this unprovoked attack.

Subsequent to the assault, the victim, after remaining on the floor for several minutes, crawled onto a bunk next to where he was laying. He remained in bunk for another minute or two before he was helped to his feet by another detainee who removed his bloody shirt. The victim then stumbled into the shower.

At the direction of the Defendant, Several other detainees then cleaned up blood from the floor where the victim had been laying and removed the bloodstained linens from the bunk onto which he had climbed.

Based on your Affiant's review of the surveillance video, it was clearly apparent that the Defendant, a validated member of the Black Guerilla Family (BGF) Security Threat Group, was responsible for organizing the assault and that he orchestrated the clean up of the crime scene and disposal of potential evidence by directing other detainees to clean the floor and remove bloody clothing and linens.

All of these events occurred in the city of Baltimore, Maryland.
