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RESPONDED TO A STRUCTURE FIRE ON POPLAR GROVE ROAD AFTER LEARNING THAT COUNTY FIRE TRUCKS HAD BEEN DISPATCHED TO A HOUSE FIRE. I ARRIVED ON THE SCENE AT 0400 HOURS. SEVERAL FIRE TRUCKS WERE ALREADY ON THE SCENE AND RESIDENCE WAS FULLY ENGULFED IN FLAMES. VICTIMS WERE BELIEVED TO STILL BE IN THE RESIDENCE. BOTH CARS WERE STILL PARKED AT THE RESIDENCE. I TALKED WITH NEIGHBORS THAT LIVED NEARBY AND IT WAS STATED TO ME THAT THEY THOUGHT THEY HEARD WHAT SOUNDED LIKE AN EXPLOSION. LOOKING TOWARD THE RESIDENCE THEY WITNESSED A CAR OR TRUCK LEAVING THE SCENE. VEHICLE WAS LOUD. IT WAS NOW APPEARING TO ME THAT FOUL PLAY OR ARSON COULD BE INVOLVED. RECOVERING OR FINDING THE FIRST BODY AT 0530 HOURS. DETECTIVES AND SHERIFF ABSTON WERE SUMMONS TO THE SCENE AND AN INVESTIGATION WAS BEGAN.
