NARRATIVE:

THE ABOVE ACCUSED IS A SUSPECT IN AN AGGRAVATED ASSAULT CASE, HE AND HIS GIRLFRIEND WERE AT HER RESIDENCE AT THE ABOVE LOCATION, AFTER RETURNING FROM WALMART WHERE ONE OF THE VICTIM'S IS EMPLOYED. ONCE THE SUSPECTS WHO WAS LOCATED OFFICERS OBSERVED TO SEE WHAT IF ANYTHING THE SUSPECT WAS PLANNING. AFTER SITTING AT THE LOCATION FOR APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR AND A HALF. THE SUSPECT CAME OUT OF THE RESIDENCE WITH HIS 16 YEARS OLD GIRLFRIEND AND FIRED A SEMI-AUTOMATIC WEAPON TEN (10) TIMES. 911 WAS ADVISED AND REPORTING OFFICER WENT TO THE RESIDENCE AND SAW BOTH SUSPECTS RUN INSIDE, THE SUSPECT WAS ALSO HOLDING A FIREARM. THEY BOTH WERE ORDERED TO STOP AND ALSO TO BRING THE WEAPON BACK OUTSIDE OVER HIS HEAD. THE 16 YEAR OLD CAME OUT WITH A WEAPON WHICH BELONGED TO HER FATHER, A .308 WHICH HAD NOT BEEN FIRED.

I ADVISED BOTH SUSPECTS OF THAT FACT AND THE SUSPECT STATED THE GUN BELONGED TO HIS GIRLFRIEND'S FATHER AND HE DID NOT HAVE A WEAPON IN HIS VEHICLE OR RESIDENCE OF HIS GIRLFRIEND. ONCE HE WAS PLACED INSIDE THE PATROL VEHICLE HIS GIRLFRIEND STATED THE WEAPON HE WAS FIRING WAS INSIDE, AND IT BELONGED TO THE SUSPECT ALSO HE HAD FIRED IT EARLIER THIS DATE. SHE BROUGHT THE WEAPON OUTSIDE AND AN ADDITIONAL EMPTY MAGAZINE. WHEN THE SUSPECT WITNESSED HIS GIRLFRIEND GIVE ME HIS WEAPON HE BEGAN TO TELL THE REPORTING OFFICER THAT IF SOMETHING HAD HAPPENED WITH THAT WEAPON IT DID NOT BELONG TO HIM, IT BELONGED TO A FRIEND AT WORK.
