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Ask Mr. Camp to come in, please, Thomas Camp.

MR. ABERNATHY: Judge, may I approach and get this marked now?

THE COURT: Sure.

[The jury enters the courtroom.]

MS. COLSTON: Your Honor, I am going to object to anybody coming in that is not on the witness list, and this person is not on the witness list. I have not been notified.

THE COURT: Come up.

[Inaudible colloquy between Court and counsel and outside the hearing of all others.]

THE COURT: Ladies and Gentlemen, just sit there and be at ease for just a minute. We need to take care of one procedural matter. Ms. Colston, he is sitting right here. Mr. Camp, go out there and talk to Ms. Colston for a minute.

[Mr. Camp leaves the witness stand and then returns.]

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**THOMAS DALE CAMP**

was called as a witness by and on behalf of the Defense, and after being first duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

**DIRECT EXAMINATION**

1 BY MR. ABERNATHY:

2 Q What is your name, sir?

3 A Dale Camp.

4 Q Do you have a son?

5 A Yes, sir, I do.

6 Q What is his name?

7 A His name is Travis Camp.

8 Q Mr. Camp, did you have an occasion to buy a truck  
9 from Johnny Watkins?

10 A Yes, sir, I did.

11 Q What kind of truck was that?

12 A It was a '85 Chevrolet Silverado.

13 Q '85 Chevrolet Silverado?

14 A Yes, sir.

15 Q What color was it?

16 A It is silver and blue, kind of a metallic silver  
17 and metallic blue.

18 Q All right. Let me show you what has been marked  
19 Defendant's Exhibit Seven and ask you if you can identify  
20 that document?

21 A Yes, sir, I can.

22 Q What is it?

23 A That is where I put in for a loan to buy the truck  
24 on 7 of November of '98?

25 A Of '98?

1 A Yes, sir, '98.

2 Q When did you buy that vehicle?

3 A I bought it the 7th of November. I borrowed the  
4 money and bought the truck the same day.

5 Q On the 7th of November of 1998?

6 A Yes, sir.

7 Q And have you owned that truck ever since?

8 A Yes, sir, I still have it.

9 Q You own it now?

10 A Yes, sir, I do.

11 Q Have you ever loaned it to Joey Watkins?

12 A No, sir, I haven't.

13 Q Has he ever driven your truck since you have owned  
14 it?

15 A No, sir, I don't think so.

16 Q So September of '99, he would not have been driving  
17 your truck?

18 A No, sir, he wouldn't. It would have been at  
19 Associated Distributors where I was a security officer. I  
20 had a lot of late hours, and it was parked there most of the  
21 time.

22 Q So if someone testified that they saw him in  
23 September of '99 driving your truck chasing somebody up the  
24 road, that wouldn't be true; would it?

25 A No, sir, that would be not true.

1 MR. ABERNATHY: All right. I would offer into  
2 evidence Defendant's Exhibit 7.

3 MS. COLSTON: No objection.

4 THE COURT: It is admitted.

5 MR. ABERNATHY: Thank you, Mr. Camp. Ms. Colston  
6 may have a few questions for you.

7 THE COURT: Ms. Colston.

8 \*\*\*\*\*

9 CROSS-EXAMINATION

10 BY MS. COLSTON:

11 Q Did you ever loan it to your son, Mr. Camp?

12 A He may have driven it on occasion, but probably  
13 just to go back and forth to work.

14 MS. COLSTON: All right. Thank you.

15 THE COURT: Step down. You are free to leave, Mr.  
16 Camp. Counsel.

17 MR. O'DELL: Your Honor, we will call Travis Camp.

18 THE COURT: Travis Camp.

19 MS. COLSTON: Same objection, Your Honor. This is  
20 another witness, but I did talk to outside though. But  
21 I just want to bring it to the Court's attention.

22 THE COURT: All right. How many more witnesses  
23 that aren't on the witness list are you going to call?

24 MR. O'DELL: This is the only one, Your Honor.

25 THE COURT: Well --

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MR. O'DELL: And this was in their information that they gave us.

THE COURT: Okay.

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**TRAVIS CAMP**

was called as a witness by and on behalf of the Defense, and after being first duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

**DIRECT EXAMINATION**

**BY MR. O'DELL:**

Q Please state your name.

A My name is Travis Camp.

Q And where do you live, Mr. Camp?

A 75 North Drive.

Q Do you know Joey Watkins?

A Yes.

Q Do you know Adam Elrod?

A Yes.

Q Did you know Isaac Dawkins? Did you know him?

A Yes.

Q Did you have an occasion around September -- August, September of 1999 to be in a vehicle with Adam Elrod on U.S. Highway 27 in the Armuchee area and see either Joey Watkins or Isaac Dawkins pass you?

A No.

1 Q Did you have an occasion to see Joey Watkins  
2 chasing Isaac Dawkins in a Silverado?

3 A No.

4 Q Were you ever in a vehicle at that time to the best  
5 of your knowledge with Adam Elrod?

6 A No.

7 Q Have you ever seen Joey Watkins --

8 MS. COLSTON: I am going to object to leading, Your  
9 Honor.

10 THE COURT: Don't suggest the answers to him in  
11 your answers, please.

12 Q Have you ever seen Joey Watkins chase Isaac Dawkins  
13 on any occasion?

14 A No.

15 MR. O'DELL: The district attorney may have some  
16 questions to ask you on that. Thank you.

17 \*\*\*\*\*

18 CROSS-EXAMINATION

19 BY MS. COLSTON:

20 Q Travis, you know that it would be wrong to chase  
21 somebody down the road and run them off the road and push  
22 them off the road where dirt would fly up and do things like  
23 that; don't you?

24 A Yes.

25 Q You wouldn't want to be a part of that; would you?

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A No.

Q Did you ever drive your dad's pickup truck?

A No.

Q Never?

A I have before.

Q You have before.

MS. COLSTON: Nothing further.

THE COURT: All right. Go outside, please. Don't talk to anybody about your testimony. Counsel.

MR. O'DELL: We call Detective Jim Moser.

THE COURT: Detective Moser.

[Detective Moser takes the stand.]

THE COURT: You are still under oath from your prior testimony, Detective.

THE WITNESS: Yes, sir.
