THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION WAS REPORTED BY PERRY MAYNARD, FLOYD COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT:

IN FEBRUARY OF 2000, THE FATHER WHO WAS GOING TO VISIT HIS SON'S (ISAAC DAWKINS CASE # 2000-1001418) GRAVE SITE NOTICED A DEAD DOG LYING ON TOP OF IT. THE FATHER REMOVED THE DEAD DOG FROM HIS SON'S GRAVE SITE AND INTO SOME NEARBY WOODS.

THE FATHER RETURNED TO WHERE THE DEAD DOG WAS LYING SOME NINE (9) MONTHS LATER AND NOTICED THAT THE DEAD DOG HAD A GSW TO ITS FOREHEAD. THE FATHER RETURNED WITH A METAL DETECTOR AND NOTICED THAT THE DETECTOR WAS SIGNALING THAT THERE WAS METAL IN THE DOG. THE FATHER THEN BAGGED UP THE DOG AND TOOK IT TO AUTHORITIES.

THE DOG IS TO BE X-RAYED AT THE SUMMERVILLE DOFS.
