On Tuesday, November 2, 2000, at approximately 9:45 a.m., SPECIAL AGENT R. R. RHODES, JR., and DETECTIVE LT. DALE BUNDY, of the Camden County Sheriff's Office, interviewed GREGORY RUFFNER at the Glynn County Detention Facility in Brunswick, Georgia. RUFFNER is a potential witness in reference to this investigation. DETECTIVE BUNDY obtained information that RUFFNER had potential information in reference to DENNIS PERRY, who is an inmate in the Glynn County Detention Facility at the Glynn County Sheriff's Office. AGENT RHODES obtained the following pertinent information.

RUFFNER stated he was working the laundry detail in the jail approximately two to three weeks ago when he entered the cell of DENNIS PERRY. RUFFNER stated PERRY asked him if he could wash his blanket on his bed because, "niggers keep putting their arms on my blanket". RUFFNER advised PERRY then stated, "I have these mother fucking niggers and if I ever get the chance again I'll kill me another one".

RUFFNER stated he did not know PERRY at this time, but as he read the newspapers several weeks later, he recognized PERRY's picture in the paper in reference to an article printed about PERRY's preliminary hearing.

RUFFNER agreed to take a Polygraph examination in reference to this statement. RUFFNER further provided AGENT RHODES with a piece of paper, which RUFFNER stated he wrote DENNIS PERRY's comment down right after he stated it. The piece of paper RUFFNER provided AGENT RHODES can be located at the rear of this case file.

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No further pertinent information was obtained, thus the interview was concluded at approximately 10:00 a.m.
