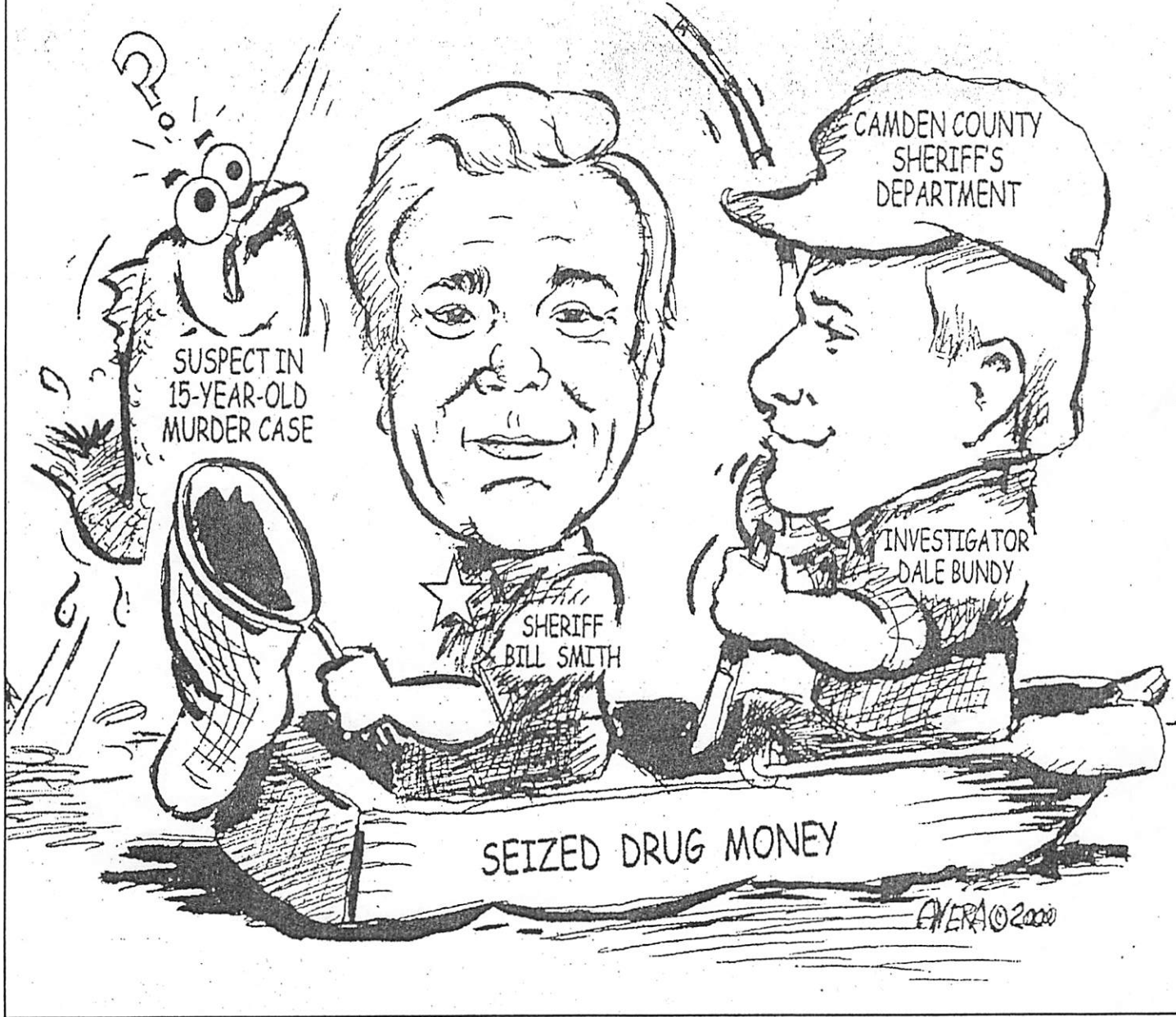

The shooting deaths of Harold and Thelma Swain at Rising Daughter Baptist Church rocked the community.

Murder cases don't get any colder than this one, but Sheriff Bill Smith refused to give up hope of bringing the killer to justice.

Smith, using seized drug money, hired a special investigator to find some answers to this puzzling crime.

A year and a half and \$40,000 later, a Florida man now faces charges. Only a court of law will determine if this is the same man who pulled the trigger and then fled, eluding police for 15 years.
