Q. Officer, could you tell me what took you to 6120 Sansom St on 8-6-96?

A. I responded to a radio call at 11¹³ PM of a person with a gun, shooting and hospital case at 6120 Sansom. On arrival, one of the footbeat units was already on location, saying it was a founded shooting, Rescue was already on location. I looked around outside for any evidence and seeing none I went inside. I went to the kitchen, there are four rooms on the first floor, the kitchen the deceased was in was the third room. Rescue ~~was~~ was working on the male and A/O Butts was doing the paper and talking to witnesses.

CONTINUED:

At 11²³ AM, Medic 29 pronounced the male, I had already started the Crime Scene log. P/O Perkins notified radio and gave them conditions of the scene. The victim was lying on his back with his torso in front of the refrigerator, his head pointing south towards the back kitchen. I saw what appeared to be a gunshot wound in the area of the victims waist. I checked the area for any shell casings, but didn't see anything at the time. There was a kitchen chair knocked over, but everything else appeared to be somewhat in order. There appeared to be a clear fluid on the floor by his left torso, there was very minimal blood on his stomach.

Q. Did you speak to any witnesses at the scene?

A. No, not personally, but I heard the witness that was brought down here that OMAR and DENISE were also in the house, and something about an argument over money.
